SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS: Always use the Wipes Warmer on stable, flat surface and arrange cord to prevent accidents. Do not put the cord, plug or Wipes Warmer in water or any other liquid. Keep out of reach of children. This product is designed to warm baby wipes only. Do not use for any other purpose. Do not cover with any material.

WARNING: To protect against burns, electrical shock, fire and accident, use the Wipes Warmer only in accordance with the following instructions.

OPERATION: Plug the unit into a standard 110-240V wall outlet. The power indicator light will be on when functioning properly and the unit will begin warming.

EVER-FRESH®: All Prince Lionheart Wipes Warmers (except for Compact Wipes Warmers) come with the patented EVER-FRESH® System. Before placing wipes within the Warmer, remove the Ever-Fresh® pillow from its package, saturate with water, then place the pillow in the base of the Wipes Warmer. If your Warmer model comes with the Pillow Case™ or Water Reservoir™, place the saturated EVER-FRESH® pillow into the Case or Reservoir before positioning within base of the Wipes Warmer. The lower compartment of the Water Reservoir™ should be filled with water before placing the saturated pillow within the top compartment. The TipTop™ Pillow (if included with your model) should be rinsed/saturated and inserted into the Wipes Warmer's lid each time a new stack of wipes is added to your Warmer.

WIPES: Remove standard or pop-up wipes from original packaging, lift the lid and drop in a stack of baby wipes (approximately 80-100 wipes or enough to allow the lid to completely close - Compact Wipes Warmer holds approximately 30 wipes). For proper dispensing of pop-up wipes, remember to place wipes correct side up as noted on wipes packaging. Allow three hours to reach full temperature.

MAINTENANCE: EVER-FRESH® and TipTop™ Pillow should be rinsed/saturated every week or each time you replenish a new stack of wipes. Please make sure to replace with a new EVER-FRESH® and TipTop Pillow™ every three (3) months.

If you keep your EVER-FRESH® pillow correctly saturated and wipes are dispensed daily, you will never experience dry or discolored wipes. However, should the Wipes Warmer be plugged in for a prolonged time period without dispensing wipes, it is possible that the EVER-FRESH® pillow may become dry and you may notice some wipes discoloration as a result of prolonged heat expo-sure. This is not hazardous, just unsightly. It
